Prov 22:6 (NIV) Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it.

1 Cor 10:13 No temptation has seized you except WHAT IS COMMON to man [mankind].

Mixing The Problems With The Word:

Eph 6:4 Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.
