Acts 16:1 (NIV) He came to Derbe and then to Lystra, where a disciple named Timothy lived, whose mother was a Jewess and a believer, but whose father was a Greek.

2 Cor 12:9 (NIV) But He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, SO THAT Christ's power may rest on me.

Faith Vs. Weakness:

- 2 Tim 1:12 (NIV) That is why I am suffering as I am. Yet I am not ashamed, because I know Whom I have believed, and am convinced that He is able to guard what I have entrusted to Him for that day.
- 2 Cor 12:9b (NIV) Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, SO THAT Christ's power may rest on me.
- 2 Cor 5:7 (NIV) We live by faith, not by sight.
